A Hundred Years of the Catholic Church in Newington

A Historical Look Back: Over the past 100 years, Annunciation Parish was blessed to have 8 men ordained to the priesthood; Rev. Jordan Charbonneau O.F.M. (1950), Rev. Joseph Vujs (1957), Rev. Robert Vujs, MM (1961), Rev. Daniel O'Connor (1961), Msgr. Frank Matera (1968), Rev. Joseph Gamba (1970), Rev. John Gatzak (1975), and Rev. Joseph MacNeill (2021).

This column will focus on: Rev. Joseph Vujs, and his brother Rev. Robert Vujs, MM. will be featured in next week's bulletin.



Rev. Joseph Vujs and Rev. Robert Vujs, two brothers, were born in Hartford, and moved to Newington at an early age. The family consisted of four sons and one daughter. Father "Joe", as everyone called him, was born on September 28, 1929, and was a man of deep spirituality. He lived his faith with unfailing kindness and gentleness, a keen sense of justice and a devotion to lifelong learning. He was valedictorian of his high school class and attended Wesleyan University with the intention of becoming a medical doctor. While he was in college, he decided to join the priesthood. He attended St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore, MD, and was ordained a priest on May 25, 1957. He later received a Doctor of Ministry from Hartford Seminary in 1987. Father Joe served at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Washington Depot, CT. After that assignment, he ministered in several other parishes in Connecticut, including St. John of the Cross in Middlebury, St. Claire in East Haven, and St. James in Manchester. He was named Pastor of St. Mary's Church in New Britain, where he found his calling to help those in need and address issues of social justice. He served at St. Rose of Lima Church in Meriden as a member of the Collaborative Ministry Team. His last parish before he retired was St. Bernard's in Enfield. In his retirement years, he continued his ministry by celebrating the Eucharist wherever he was needed and providing the sacraments to patients at MidState Medical Center in Meriden. Father Joe passed away on Tuesday, May 16, 2023. A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated by Archbishop Leonard P. Blair on Tuesday, May 23rd at St. Mary's Church, with burial at West Meadow Cemetery in Newington.

The 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B features readings that emphasize faith, sacrifice, and trust in God. These themes help us reflect on our relationship with God and others.

- **Trust in God's plan:** In 1 Kings 17:10-16, the widow trusts Elijah's word from God and is blessed with food. This shows that trusting God's plan brings blessings.
- **Generosity in poverty:** The widow in Mark 12:38-44 gives all she has. Her generosity shows that true giving comes from the heart, not from excess.
- **Sacrifice:** Hebrews 9:24-28 speaks about Jesus' sacrifice. Jesus' offering of himself is the ultimate act of love and service.
- **Humility:** Jesus criticizes the scribes in Mark 12:38-44 for their pride. Humility is important in our relationship with God and others.
- **Faith in God's promises:** The widow in 1 Kings 17:10-16 acts on faith. Believing in God's promises leads to unexpected blessings.
- **Jesus as the mediator:** Hebrews 9:24-28 describes Jesus as the mediator between God and humanity. This emphasizes the importance of Jesus in our salvation.
- **True wealth:** The story of the widow's mite in Mark 12:38-44 shows that true wealth is not measured by money. It's about giving and trusting in God.

Obedience to God: Elijah asks the widow to make bread in 1 Kings 17:10-16, and she obeys. Her obedience leads to God providing for her needs.

The readings for the 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B remind us of the importance of trust, faith, and humility in our lives. Reflecting on these themes can strengthen our relationship with God and guide us in our daily actions.




