

A Hundred Years of the Catholic Church in Newington

A Historical Look Back:

Rev. Robert Vujs, MM was born on February 17, 1933, and was raised in Newington. His father ran a grocery store/ meat market. He was deeply involved with St. Mary's Church as a Minister of the Eucharist, helping with distributing communion. Growing up "Father Bob" as everyone called him, enjoyed reading the Maryknoll magazine and liked studying geography. So, in 1951, after high school graduation, he enrolled in Maryknoll Fathers and Brothers, a Catholic Foreign Mission Society of America, located in Ossining, New York. Father Bob was ordained on June 10, 1961 from Maryknoll. (His mother thought he would last only six months at Maryknoll!) His first assignment was in Tanzania, Africa. By the way, the Pastor of St. Mary's Church at the time, had a special parish collection for Father Bob so he could buy his first mission truck – a 404 Puget!! He purchased the vehicle when he arrived in Africa. Father Bob served in Tanzania, Africa from 1961 to 1970. He lived in the rural areas setting up Catholic Schools and Parishes. Father Bob used his Puget Truck, an efficient vehicle for transporting people back and forth from their villages to a "Main Station" for Catholic instructions and liturgies. In 1970 he moved to Nairobi, Kenya setting up Catholic Schools and Parishes. God blessed Father Bob when the CEO of International Montessori Schools from England agreed to establish a Montessori teacher training college in Nairobi. This year the college celebrated its 50th Anniversary having trained 3,000 pre-school teachers...what a gift from Our Father! Father Bob also set up schools from kindergarten to eighth grade. The schools are managed by Indian Sisters and local Kenyan teachers. Father Bob continued to serve in Nairobi until his retirement in 2005. When Father Bob returned home from Africa, he remained very active. He volunteered as a court interpreter for Swahili, he was the Chaplain at the Veterans Hospital in West Haven, at the Chesire Prison he said bi-weekly Mass and met weekly with adults and teenager groups, helping local parishes with weekend liturgies. For the past seven years, he has spent weekends traveling around the United States for "Food for the Poor", an organization to aid the poor and downtrodden.

The 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B invites us to reflect on the end times and the hope we have in Christ. The readings highlight themes of final judgment, perseverance, and salvation.

- **Final Judgment:** Daniel 12:1-3 talks about a time of great distress but also about those who will be saved. It reminds us that there will be a final judgment where the faithful will shine like stars.
- **Resurrection and Eternal Life:** In Daniel, we hear about those who sleep in the dust awakening to everlasting life. This gives us hope in the promise of resurrection and eternal life with God.
- **Christ's Sacrifice:** Hebrews 10:11-14, 18 speaks of Jesus' single sacrifice for sins. It emphasizes that through Jesus, we are forgiven and made holy.
- **Perseverance in Faith:** The readings encourage us to stay firm in our faith, even during difficult times. This perseverance is necessary to receive the promises of God.
- **Hope in Tribulation:** Mark 13:24-32 describes the coming of the Son of Man during troubling times. Despite these tribulations, we have hope in Jesus' return and ultimate victory.
- **God's Faithfulness:** The readings highlight that God will fulfill His promises. We can trust in His faithfulness even when the world seems uncertain.

These themes for the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B remind us of the importance of faith and hope in the face of trials. They encourage us to stay faithful, knowing that God's promises will be fulfilled in the end.
