Registration begins at 12:00 noon and the walk begins at 1:00 rain or shine.** The public is invited to participate in this event that offers parents, brothers and sisters, relatives and friends the chance to stand together and remember babies and children of all ages whom they love and have lost.

A bagpiper will lead participants to the non-denominational "Cherish Our Children Angel Statue" at West Meadow Cemetery in Newington. Participants will be given a white flower that they may leave at the angel statue, along with a personal note of remembrance. A short program will be presented including a special guest speaker, music, and the reading of children's names to be remembered.

There is no fee to participate in the walk.
