Q. What happens if I have a mass intention for a time no longer available?

What Is a Marriage Convalidation?

A convalidation is raising a civil marriage to the level of the sacrament in the Church as required by the Church for all Catholics.

It is a solution to the fact that the parties have officially left the sacramental life of the Church by not having a Catholic wedding. Convalidation is a remedy to bring those couples back to the Church and Her sacraments. Catholic couples married civilly have created a grave offense, though they may not recognize it. Because it is a serious sin, they are not to be admitted to Communion or even the sacrament of Reconciliation, because of their irregular status. The Church welcomes and celebrates convalidations because it allows Catholics to return to Mother Church and Her sacraments and the grace of God.

The clergy of the parish are excited to welcome anyone in this situation to raise their civil marriage to a sacrament, which does not take much time or cost. Sometimes, this is referred to as a "Blessing of a Marriage," but, it is a new act of consent to be married by both spouses. They exchange wedding vows out loud. It can take place during Mass or outside of Mass.

There are cases where the Catholic spouse regrets having contracted an invalid marriage outside of the canonical ceremony and wishes to have the marriage validated, but the other spouse refuses to go through another ceremony. In that case, the Church in Her mercy and wisdom can grant a retroactive validation (radical sanation) of the marriage per canon law.

Anyone desiring more information about marriage convalidation can contact any of the parish clergy.
