## Vocation Awareness: *Called By Name*

*Called By Name* is an initiative which takes much of the worry out of the discernment process. There are many vocations to the priesthood and religious life which are never realized simply because no one has ever invited them. *Called By Name* changes that.

You can use the submission card to write down the name of a person whom you think may have a calling to be a priest or nun. You can also use the QR code to nominate the person electronically. Fill in as much information as you can and don't worry if you can't provide it all.

A person nominated does not need to make any commitments. They will receive a letter from Archbishop Coyne congratulating them on living the Christian life in an exemplary way and be invited to begin discerning God's calling through the Vocations Office in the normal manner.

Other dioceses which have done *Called By Name* have reported astonishing numbers of new priests and religious sisters simply by inviting them to begin the discernment process.

Please take a moment to prayerfully nominate a person whom you think might have a calling from God and imagine if this was the moment a vocation began because you made it so that they could be called by name.

CALLED BY NAME

*Thank you so much for nominating a person whom you think Jesus might be calling to be a priest, deacon, or religious sister. Those you nominate will receive a letter from the Archbishop, congratulating them on living the Christian life in an exemplary way and gently inviting them to begin formally discerning their calling, as well as much helpful information and resources. There are no requirements or commitments on their part – only a loving invitation from the Lord.*

## Themes for the 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B

The readings for the 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time show God's response to human failure and His promise of hope. They highlight themes of disobedience, faith, and the true family of Jesus.

- **Disobedience and Consequences:** Adam and Eve disobey God and face consequences. This reading shows the reality of sin and its impact.
- **Promise of Redemption:** God promises victory over sin through the offspring of the woman. This points to Jesus, who will defeat sin.
- **Faith Amid Hardship:** Believers are encouraged to stay strong in their faith despite hardships. They look forward to eternal glory with hope.
- **Redefining Family:** Jesus teaches that true family is based on doing God's will. Spiritual kinship is more important than blood relations.
- **Opposition to Jesus:** Jesus faces opposition from His family and religious leaders. He remains focused on His mission and God's will.
- **Spiritual Kinship:** Jesus emphasizes that those who follow God are His true family. Obedience to God's commands makes one part of Jesus' family.

The themes remind us of the reality of sin and the hope of redemption. They call us to strong faith, spiritual kinship, and obedience to God.

The 10th Sunday invites us to deepen our understanding of God's mercy and compassion. As we delve into the depths of these readings, we are reminded of the importance of repentance, faith, and embracing God's mercy. They challenge us to reflect on our own lives, recognizing our shortcomings and seeking genuine repentance. They invite us to have unwavering faith in God's righteousness and the promise of resurrection through Jesus Christ.

Moreover, these readings encourage us to emulate Jesus' example by reaching out to the marginalized, the sinners, and the broken-hearted. They remind us that compassion knows no bounds and that God's love extends even to the most vulnerable among us.
