



A Hundred Years of the Catholic Church in Newington

A Historical Look Back:

On April 2, 1967, the third church of St. Mary in Newington opened its doors and celebrated its first Mass. The Archbishop of Hartford, the Most Reverend

Henry J. O'Brien, D.D., presided at the dedication ceremonies and the pastor, Reverend Joseph P. Father Buckley, celebrated a Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving, this

new church's first Mass. Afterwards, an open house was held for the remainder of the day offering an opportunity for parishioners and friends to tour the new structure.

The new church was of a modern design with an open floor plan. Through the main entry one entered through the baptistry which symbolizes our entrance into the Church of Christ through the sacrament of Baptism. Suspended above the recessed Baptismal Font is a bronze wire sculpture, symbolic of the Holy Spirit.

Then through a set of interior glass doors, one enters the main body or nave of the church. The main focal point in the center of the church is the Alter of Sacrifice made of carved marble. Directly above the Alter in the center section of the 60-foot-high ceiling are gray tinted skylights allowing for the sun to illuminate the interior of the spacious structure.

In addition, the walls are made up of red brick topped with multi-colored glass set in textured cement with floors of large terrazzo tiles. Both being of minimal maintenance and long lasting for future generations to come.

"An Irish Welcome" For Archbishop Coyne



By August of 1967, the old church was demolished, and the vacant lot be graded and landscaped ending another chapter in the parish's history.

Now with the new church being utilized, the fate of the old St. Mary Church was approaching its conclusion.

Father Buckley gave permission to those who wished for keepsakes of the old church to remove statues, windows, and Stations of the Cross.
