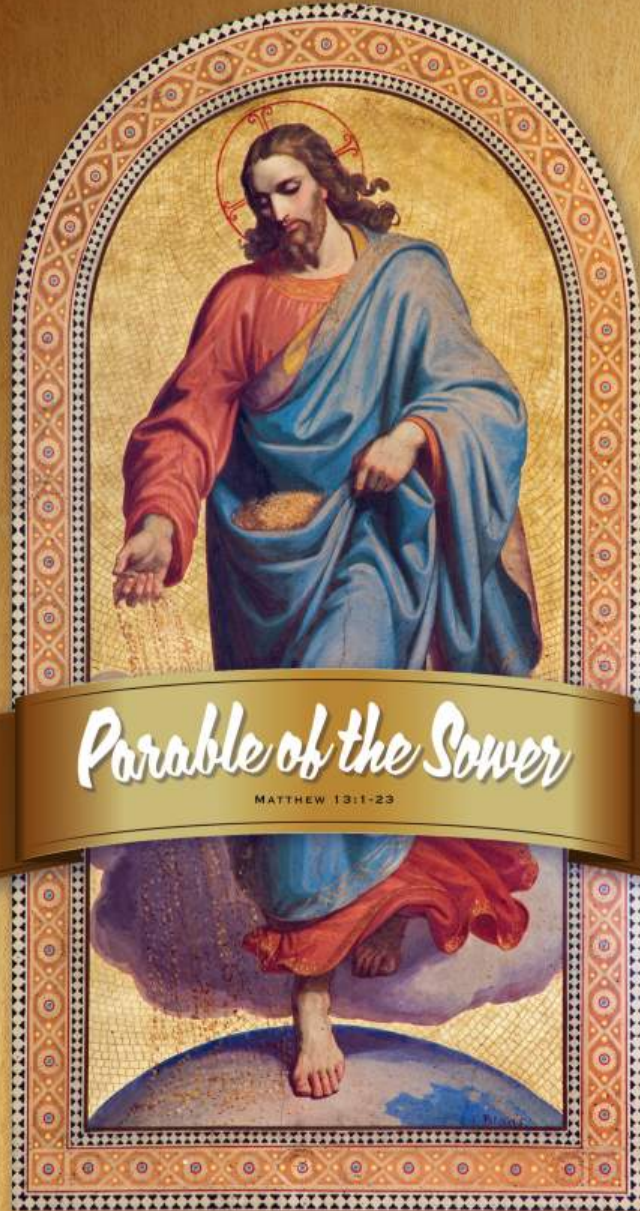

The Ministry of Usher

Every parish utilizes the ministry of usher to assist in the smooth and efficient flow of the Mass. This ministry is important, because it offers hospitality and assists the priest in tasks that he cannot accomplish, due to celebrating the liturgy.

This ministry varies across parishes. Here at Annunciation Parish, the ministry of usher is to assist in the offertory collection, which is collected after the Creed and Prayer of the Faithful. In a ministry where many people are involved, including occasional necessary substitutes, communication is often challenging.

To effectively communicate, the following is written for experienced ushers, for those interested in assisting in the ministry, and even those who occasionally step in to assist. Firstly, thank you for your help! Your assistance is appreciated. It is the hope that by publishing the proper collection procedure instructions, the process will be standardized in both Church locations and for every Mass time; plus, there is a hope that more parishioners, now that they are informed, will be more comfortable stepping in.

The following procedures are set down in accordance with Archdiocesan guidelines, and best business practices that are required to be followed in every parish. The guidelines outline how to complete the task most efficiently, and avoid any appearance of impropriety, giving the donors confidence that their generous contributions are used in their intended manner.

- 1.** Ushers are to get in position at the back of the aisles with their baskets when, during the Creed, the people pray "I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church..." It is important that the servers do not talk, since the people are praying and sound carries in the Church.
- 2.** Immediately after the closing prayer of the Prayer of the Faithful (said by the priest), the ushers are to come forward. Please do not wait, remember the ministry is one of efficiency so that the Mass may proceed.
- 3.** Take the collection in your aisle, then proceed to the table at the back of the Church with the red fabric liner in the wicker basket. The red liner is designed to be used for several reasons. They are: A. speed (ushers are to dump their basket onto the red liner and not physically handle the money and envelopes); B. prevent ushers from touching the money and envelopes (the money is dirty and you are about to receive Holy Communion and we never want to give an appearance of handling funds inappropriately); and finally, C. so that the liner can be removed quickly and placed in the plastic security bag which is located under the wicket basket and is labeled with the date and Mass time.
- 4.** After the individual usher has collected the offertory, individual baskets are poured into the one red lined basket. The red liner is to be removed and placed in the white plastic security bag. To seal the bag, remove the yellow film and press the ends together. The sealing of the bag is to be performed in public, in the Church, at the table where the red lined wicker basket is located.
- 5.** The sealed security bag is to be brought into the sacristy and placed in a cabinet. Starting in September, the white security bags will be brought in procession when the bread and wine are presented in Mass.
- 6.** If there is a second collection, the same procedure is used, except for the fact that the collection is to be segregated. Security bags are labeled by date, time and purpose.

Some, because there are always a few-unfortunately sometimes several, will complain that these procedures have to be written, or are so explicit for such a simple (yet important) task. It is important to remember that the position of usher is a ministry in the Church, and Holy Mother Church is asking ministers to do as the Church intends. Reasons have been outlined above, and it is the hope that more people will be comfortable assisting with this ministry. Again, a special note of thanks to those who have been collecting in the parish and those who step up to assist at various times, your assistance is truly appreciated.
